MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR 3570

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE OUR CENTERING SYSTEM FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

Remove existing base plate from your router. Center existing plate on the 3570, both face up.

Use 3 or 4 pieces of tape to hold the base plate in position (Fig. 1).

Secure with “C” clamps or wood clamps and fasten a scrap piece of wood to top of 3570 to prevent chipping when drilling (Fig. 2).

Using a drill bit the same size as the holes in the router's base plate, drill through the 3570. A drill press works best to guarantee perpendicular holes (Fig. 3).

Remove clamps and countersink holes on the top similar to the router's base plate. A single flute countersink running at a slow speed will produce the cleanest cuts. Use a drill press if possible (Fig. 4).

Mount the 3570 to the router.

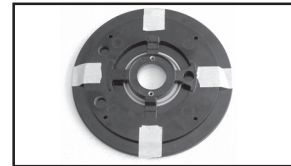

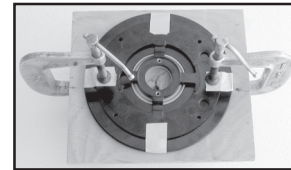

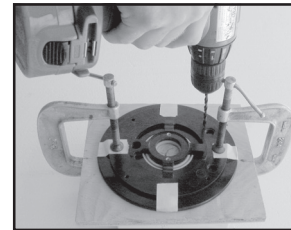

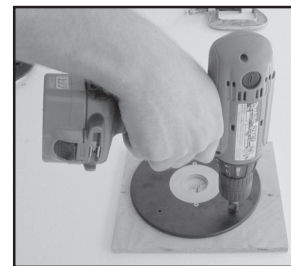
